English level: min. A2, Average high school grades

MA Description:

The aim of this course is to train high-level specialists capable of meeting the specific demands of the labor market in the fields of cultural and intercultural exchange. In addition to local, national or international authorities in the public sector, it is important to underline the growing need for French graduates in the private sector, e.g. with multinational companies.

The training will also prepare the student to continue in one of the Doctoral Schools of the Faculty.

The graduates find positions mainly in the sectors of education and research, tourism management, banking and finance, and intercultural communications.

This program gives a comprehensive overview over all areas of American studies — literature, culture, politics, history and language — and trains specialists well-versed in both the critical and applied theory concerning the United States of America. Degree holders will have solid skills to conduct independent research, to assess and process relevant information, and communicate their findings according to high academic standards.
